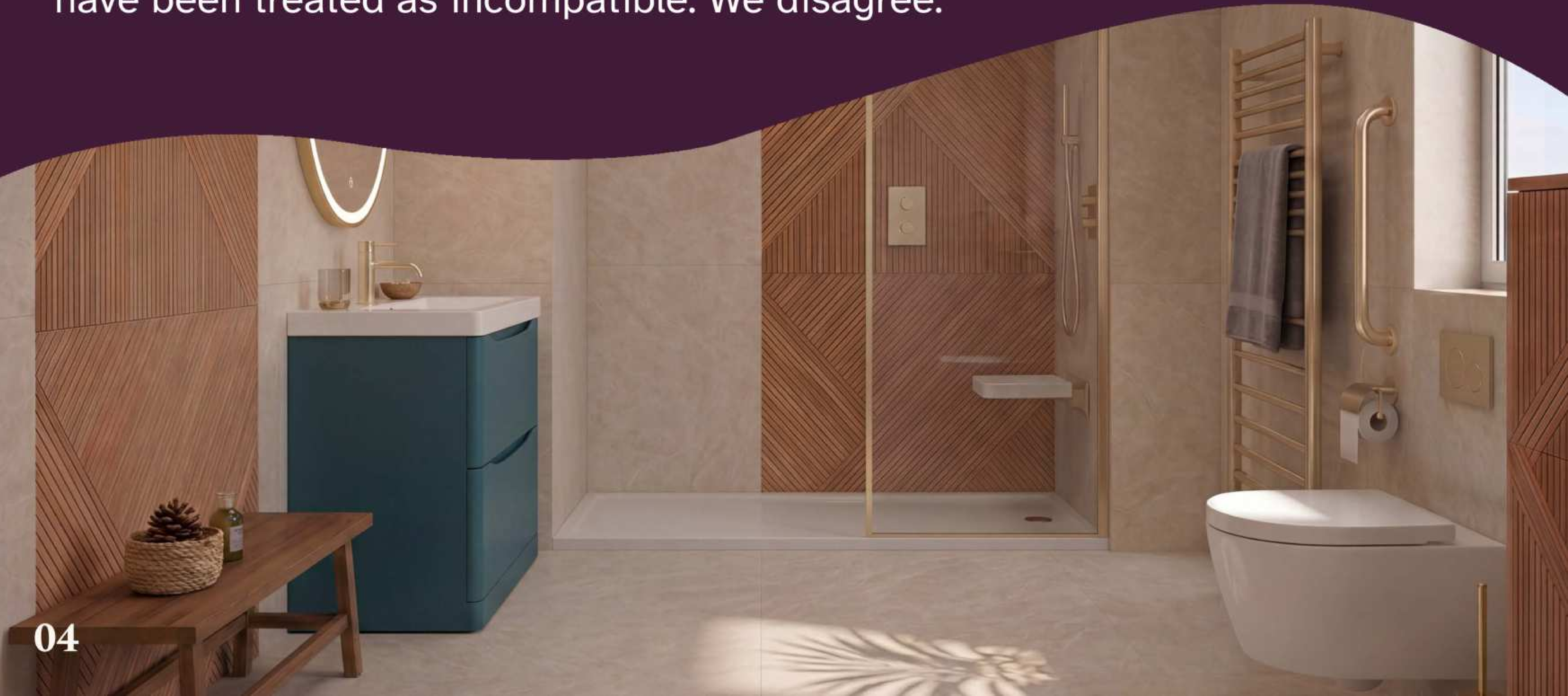

A bathroom that keeps you independent at home should also be one you are proud of. For too long, those two things have been treated as incompatible. We disagree.

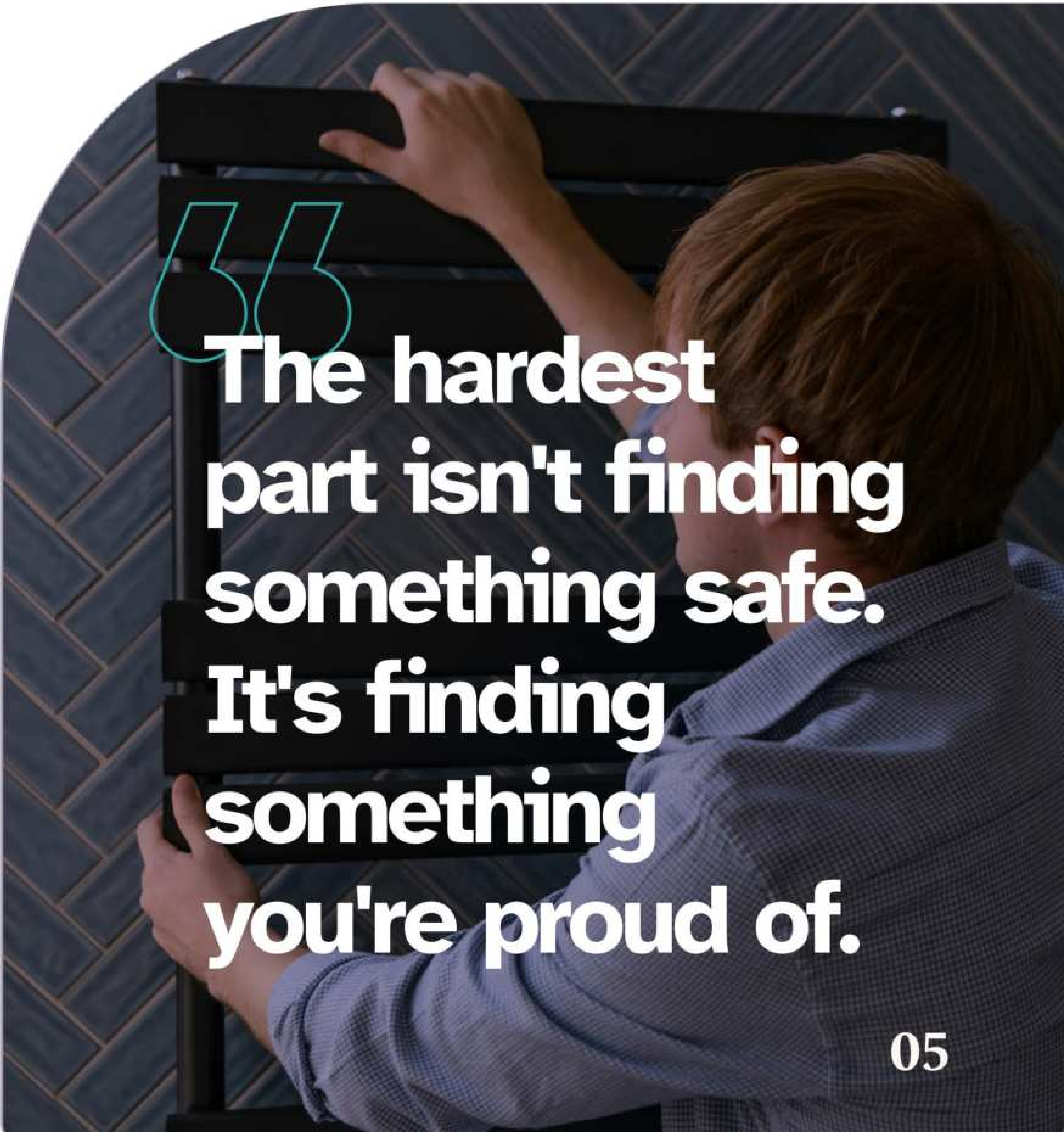


We built this business because we kept seeing the same problem.

If you've already looked at the accessible options out there, you'll know the feeling. They're designed around function, not around you. They look clinical, feel impersonal, and do nothing for the home you've spent years making your own.

Bathrooms for Life was founded on the belief that this is a false choice. There is a version of an accessible bathroom that is genuinely beautiful — one that supports your independence now and adapts with you over time, without ever looking like it was designed for someone with a problem. That's the only kind we build.

When we say Bathrooms for Life, we mean it.

Every bathroom we install comes with our lifetime guarantee.

Not a warranty buried in small print, a genuine commitment.

Why we offer this

We offer this guarantee because we believe a bathroom installation should be for life.

If something we have fitted stops working, we want you to be able to pick up the phone and have it sorted by the same people who installed it, not someone from the factory who made it.

This way you and your family can rest assured that your bathroom will last, and any issues that do arise are dealt with swiftly and professionally.

Our guarantee works in two stages.

Years one and two — full warranty

Everything is covered in full. If any product or fitting fails, or if any aspect of the installation falls short, we will come out, assess it, and resolve it at no cost to you whatsoever. No call-out charge. No parts charge. No labour charge.

Year three onwards — lifetime cover

For as long as you own your home, if anything we installed develops a genuine functional fault, we'll resolve it. The call-out is free, and if our team can fix it there and then, they will at no cost. New parts and materials are always free. If labour is needed beyond that visit, we'll give you a written estimate before any chargeable work begins. No surprises.



Built to your tastes, timelines, and preferences



Flexible design

Our packages are starting points, not boxes. Every component can be changed, upgraded, or swapped — from a single grab rail to a fully bespoke design built from scratch. If you want it, we will source it.



Flexible timelines

You set the pace. There's no deadline on a quote and no pressure to decide. If you'd like a second home visit to go over anything, we'll arrange it.

When you're ready, installation is scheduled around you — and you'll know exactly what's happening each day.



Flexible payment

No large payment is ever due before the work is done: 25% when you confirm your date, 25% on the first day of installation, and 50% only after completion, once you're satisfied. Your quoted price is a ceiling, not an estimate — if the job goes more smoothly than planned, we refund you the difference.

One dedicated person, from first hello to finished bathroom.

We are a small team and that is a strength. You will deal with the same person throughout your project. The person who answers the phone when you call our number is the same person who visits your home and understands what you want, designs your bathroom, prepares your quote, oversees your installation, and picks up the phone when you call afterwards. They know your home, your taste, and your priorities — because they heard them from you, first-hand.

What to expect from your free home visit.

We know that inviting someone into your home is not a small thing.

Here is exactly what happens, so there are no surprises.



Before the visit

We confirm your appointment by phone and tell you exactly who is coming, with a direct number to reach them. You don't need to prepare anything or clear the bathroom. And if you'd like a family member or friend there with you, please invite them along; we're happy to talk everything through with whoever you want involved.



During the visit

One person from our team attends — your dedicated designer, who handles both the design consultation and the technical survey. They'll measure the bathroom, assess the layout, plumbing, and any access requirements, talk through your priorities, show you material samples, and answer every question you have. We will always show you at least two different layouts for your potential bathroom, so you know you are getting one that works best for you. Most visits take between one and two hours. Bring your marked-up brochure and as many questions as you like.



After the visit

A new bathroom is a big decision, and good decisions take time. That's why every quote is valid for 90 days — no rush, no pressure to commit on the spot, and a second visit if you'd like one. And if questions come up, or you'd like to change something in your design, your dedicated designer is just a phone call away. The price won't shift while you think.



What it costs

Nothing. The home visit is completely free, with no obligation whatsoever.

How payment works

We split the cost into three stages so that no large payment is due before the work is done.

Deposit	25%	Due when you confirm your installation date
On Start	25%	Due on the first day of installation
On Completion	50%	Due within 5 working days of sign-off, once you are satisfied

The price on your quote is the most you will pay. If the installation is quicker and easier than we anticipated, we refund you the difference. If anything specific to your bathroom sits outside the standard scope — structural changes, replastering, electrical upgrades — we tell you at the survey stage and include it clearly in your quote. Nothing appears on your final invoice that wasn't on your quote.

We accept bank transfer, debit or credit card, cheque, and cash. If you would like to discuss a different payment arrangement, speak to us before installation begins and we will do our best to accommodate you.

The average costs shown in this brochure include VAT. However, many of the products and services we install are zero-rated for VAT purposes when supplied to a customer with a disability or a chronic illness, under HMRC rules. If this applies to you, your actual cost may be lower than the figures shown.

We will confirm the VAT position clearly on your written quote. If you have questions about whether you qualify for VAT exemption, ask us at your home visit and we will explain how it works, it's really easy!

We handle everything. That's the job.

Once you confirm, we schedule your installation and take care of everything from that point. You don't need to source anything, manage anyone, or coordinate between trades.

Installation is carried out by our fitting team — directly managed fitters and vetted specialist contractors, every one selected for their quality of finish and their conduct in customers' homes. We take both seriously.

Set a clear schedule before work begins, so you know exactly what's happening each day



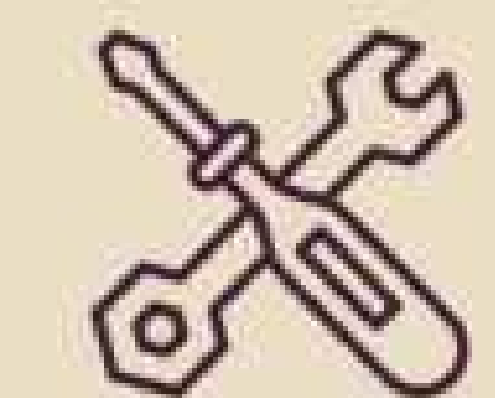

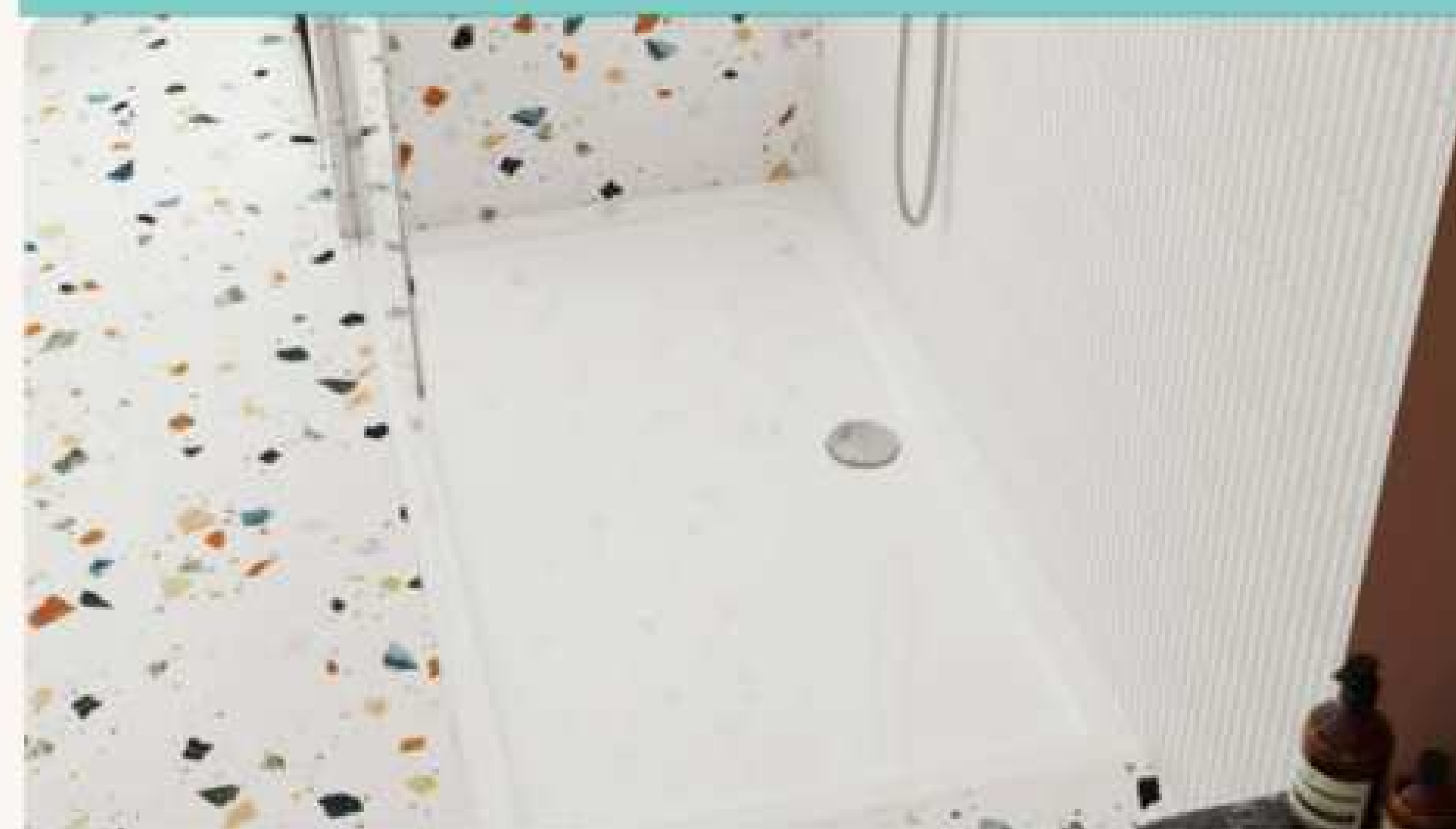

Why We *Don't* Recommend Walk-in Baths

We get asked about walk-in baths a lot. They're heavily advertised, and on paper they sound like the perfect answer. We don't sell them — and we think you deserve to know why.



Things to Consider Before Choosing a Walk-in-Bath

-  You have to be sitting inside, with the door sealed, before the bath fills and stay there while it drains. That means sitting cold and exposed, sometimes for several minutes, at both ends of every bath.

-  The fall risk doesn't go away. You still step over a threshold onto a wet surface, and the most dangerous moments, getting in and out, remain.
-  They're expensive for what they are, often costing as much as a beautiful full bathroom transformation.
-  Walk in showers with a built in seat offer the comfort of a walk in bath without the issues above

Many of our customers are not yet 65. They're living with MS, Parkinson's, or Arthritis. They're wheelchair users, tired of bathrooms that are technically compliant but aesthetically bland. They're parents of children with additional needs, they are individuals still coming to terms with a life changing injury.

We believe they all deserve a bathroom that supports their independence, with zero compromise on style.

The designs on the following pages are built from the ground up around what each person actually needs without sacrificing what they want the space to look like. Each one is an example, not a fixed product: everything you've seen in this guide, from styles to finishes, applies here too.

Bathrooms designed for clarity and calm.

Reducing confusion. Supporting independence. Maintaining dignity.

For someone living with dementia, the bathroom can become one of the most disorientating spaces in the home. The wrong colours, surfaces, and layouts can cause confusion and distress. The right ones can make using the bathroom independently feel natural and manageable for longer. We design specifically around the visual and cognitive challenges of dementia — not as an afterthought, but as the starting point.



Key design features

- High-contrast colour schemes that clearly distinguish surfaces, fittings, and floor
- Matt finishes throughout, reducing visual confusion from reflections
- Clear sight lines from the door to the toilet and shower
- Lever taps and push-button controls that are easy to identify and use
- Non-slip flooring that reads as clearly distinct from the walls
- Sensors and automatic shut offs to allow family members assurance their loved ones haven't fallen or caused a flood
- Grab rails in contrasting tones to make them easily identifiable
- Thermostatic controls with clear temperature limits to prevent scalding

Full access. Full independence. Full style.

Key design features

- Turning space of at least 1500mm for full wheelchair maneuver
- Roll-in wetroom with flush floor — no lip or threshold anywhere
- Fold-down shower seat positioned for safe lateral transfer
- Grab rails at transfer points, in finishes that match the room
- Height-adjusted basin with knee clearance for seated use
- Lever or sensor taps operable from a seated position
- Door width of at least 850mm with lever handles
- Tilt mirror to allow use while seated or stood

A bathroom that is technically accessible and one that actually works for a wheelchair user are not the same thing. Standard accessible bathrooms are often designed to a minimum specification that prioritises compliance over usability. We design around how a person actually moves through and uses the space — with enough room to transfer safely, surfaces positioned at the right height, and a layout that does not feel like a concession.



Easier to use every single day.

Reducing pain and effort at every point of contact.

Arthritis affects grip, range of motion, and the ability to apply force — which makes a standard bathroom, full of twist taps, small handles, and high thresholds, genuinely painful to use every day. We design around these challenges specifically, selecting fittings and layouts that reduce the effort required at every point of contact. The result is a bathroom that is noticeably easier to use without looking like it was designed for someone with a problem.



Key design features

- Lever or sensor taps throughout — no twist handles anywhere in the bathroom
- Push-button or sensor-flush toilet, eliminating grip requirements
- Thermostatic shower controls with large, easy-turn dials
- D-ring and bar handles on every door, cabinet, and drawer
- Walk-in shower with no step or lip to navigate
- Grab rails positioned at sit-to-stand transition points
- Comfort-height toilet, reducing the effort of sitting and standing
- Rocker light switches rather than small toggles

The Bathroom Should be the safest room in the home.

Key design features

- Level-access shower with no threshold, step, or lip of any kind
- Full non-slip flooring throughout — not just in the shower area
- Grab rails at every transition point: toilet, shower entry, and basin
- Comfort-height toilet, reducing the distance and effort of sitting and standing
- Fold-down shower seat — a seated wash with no standing balance required
- Thermostatic controls preventing the scald reactions that cause falls
- Bright, even lighting with no dark corners or shadows over key areas
- Contrasting floor and wall colours to aid depth perception
- Emergency pull cord or alarm point fitted as standard

The bathroom is statistically the most dangerous room in the home for older adults and people with mobility conditions. Most falls happen at transition points — getting in and out of the bath, stepping over a shower tray, or getting up from the toilet. We design specifically around these moments, eliminating the risks that cause falls rather than adding handrails to a bathroom that is still fundamentally hazardous.



Designed for growing independence.

Key design features

- Custom height basin and shower fittings
- Thermostatic temperature limits on every outlet — scalding is designed out, not supervised out
- Sensory-considered choices: dimmable lighting, quiet extractor fans, and calm, matt surfaces
- Full non-slip flooring and level access throughout
- Space planned for assisted care, with room for a parent or carer to move comfortably
- Robust, securely fixed fittings that stand up to enthusiastic use
- Provision for hoists or future equipment built in now, invisible until needed
- Custom themes tailored to your child, from Disney princesses to dinosaurs.

For families of children with additional needs, the bathroom is often where care is most hands-on — and where independence has the most room to grow. We design around your child and your family's routine: sensory sensitivities, safe water temperatures, space for a parent or carer to help, and fittings that adapt as your child grows. And because no child should have a clinical bathroom, we make it a room they actually love.

Key design features

- A range of screen options, from frosted glass to half height retractable
- Thermostatic temperature limits on every outlet — scalding is designed out, not supervised out
- Grab rails installed at all key transfer points
- Full non-slip flooring and level access throughout
- Space planned for assisted care, with room for both the individual and carer to move comfortably
- Shower controls that can be operated by both the individual and the carer
- Designed to be a space which can be enjoyed by both the person needing care and any family members also using the bathroom

We encourage you to bring your loved ones and those that care for you to the design meeting if you feel comfortable doing so, this way we can build a bathroom which works for everyone.

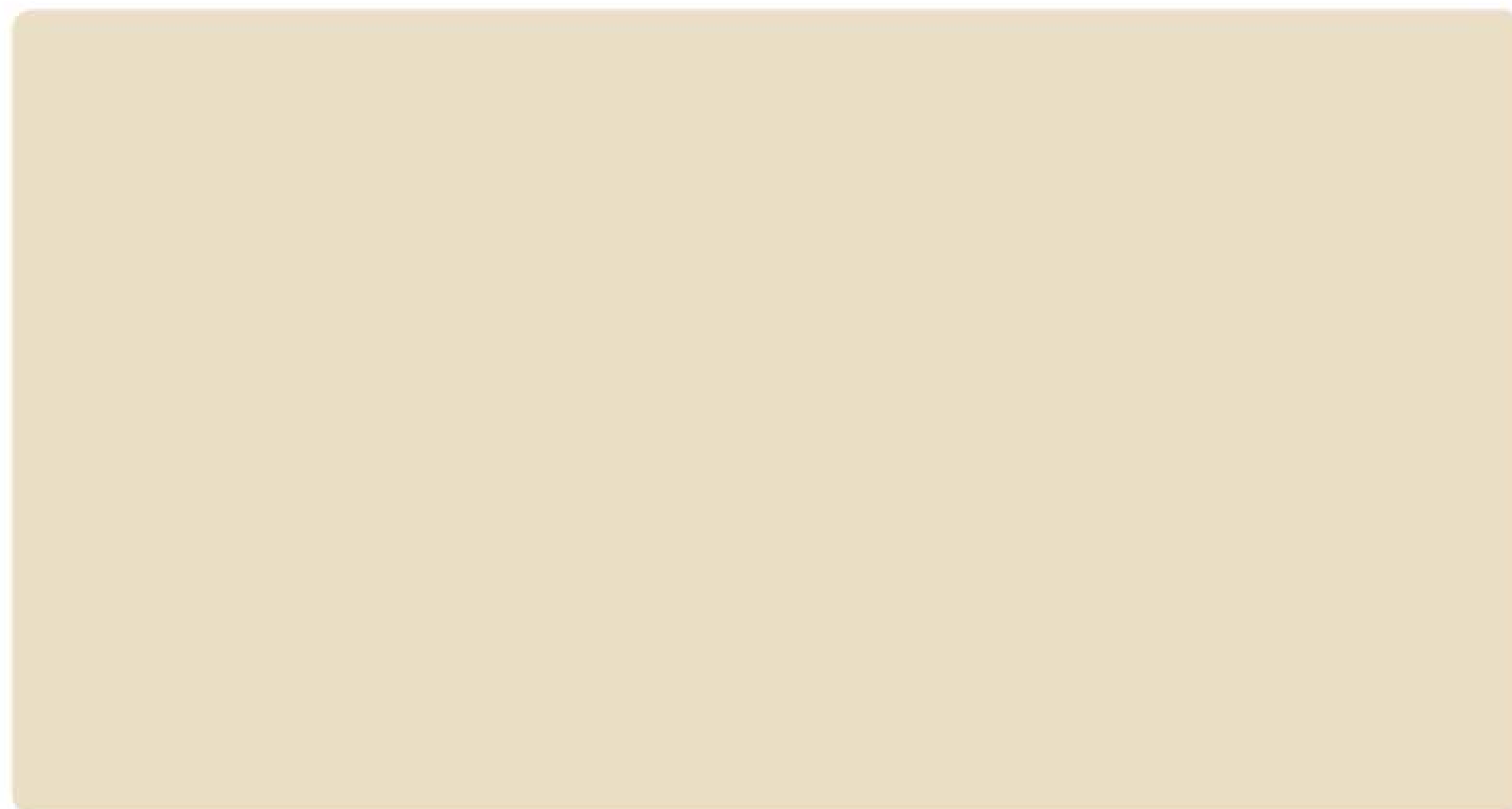

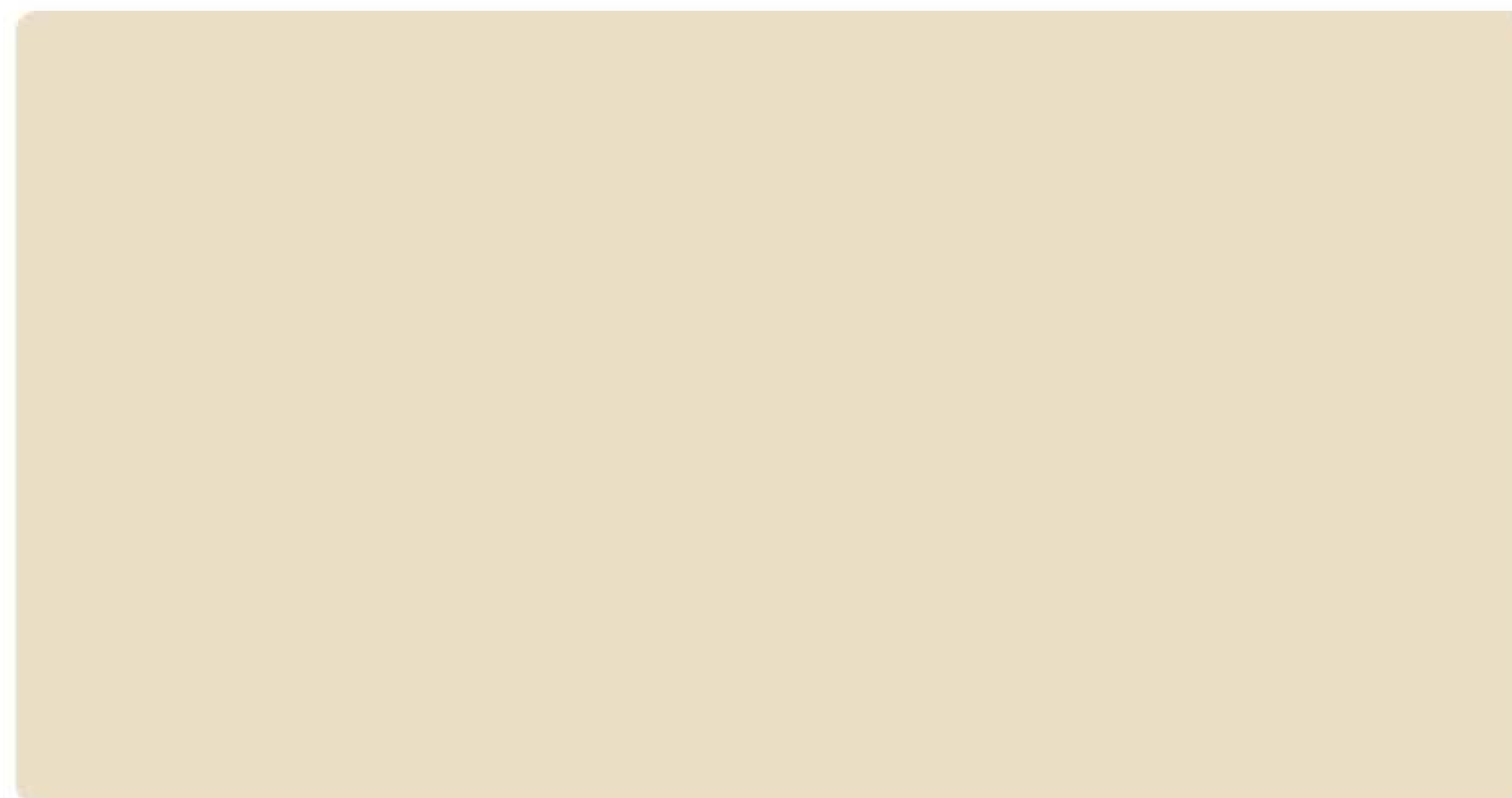

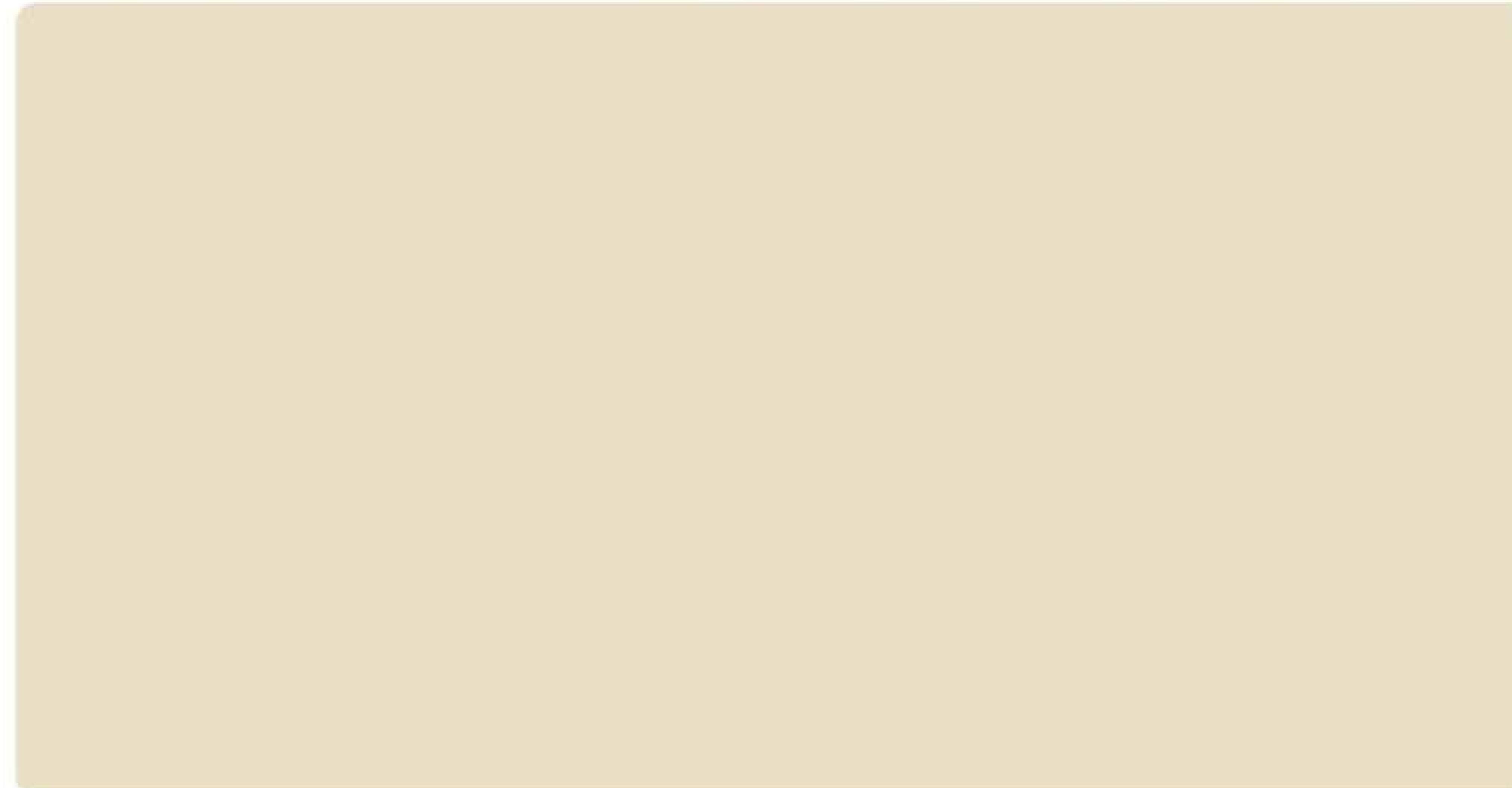
